The sentence will definitely not take place at Wood Green given the court is not authorised for the deployment of firearms.

Given the representations below the sentence could take place at one of the designated firearms courts i.e. CCC, Snaresbrook or Woolwich with the defendants being produced, however, before making a final decision Mr Justice Sweeney would like written update from an Officer at ACPO level, setting out the risk and the exact role of the court at which the sentence will take place. Please can this be forwarded to me by the latest 10:30am tomorrow morning.

If this is to be pursued Mr Justice Sweeney would like to meet with the Officer at ACPO level and the Officer in the case in his chambers at the RCJ at 2pm tomorrow, Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup>. Please can you communicate this to the relevant people.
