

PUBLIC INQUIRY INTO THE DEATH OF JERMAINE BAKER

RESTRICTION ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 19 INQUIRIES ACT 2005

CONDUCT OF THE HEARINGS

This Restriction Order is made pursuant to section 19(2)(b) of the Inquiries Act 2005 (“the Act”), read with section 19(3) of the Act.

Any threat to break such an order, or any breach of it, can be certified to the High Court or Court of Session under section 36 of the Act, and the Court will deal with it as though the breach had occurred in proceedings before that Court.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. This Order is made on 11 June 2021 and remains in force indefinitely.
2. The Chairman may vary or revoke this Order by making a further order at any point.
3. Any breach of this Order by any means whatsoever shall be notified in writing to the Solicitor to the Inquiry (STI) immediately upon identification of the breach.

Live streaming

4. The Chairman has directed that the Inquiry’s hearings, commencing on Monday 14 June 2021, will be live streamed until such time as the Government’s Covid restrictions have been lifted.
5. The Inquiry’s live stream will be delayed by three minutes.
6. There shall be no contemporaneous reporting of the hearings from the hearing room. Any Core Participant, media or member of the public, wishing to Tweet, live-blog or otherwise publish reports on the hearings must observe the three minute delay.

Redaction of documents

7. During the course of the hearing, documents adduced in evidence will be published on the Inquiry's website. At the conclusion of the hearing, additional documents may also be published on the Inquiry's website. In addition, witnesses and counsel may refer to matters within these documents during the hearing.
8. All documents published by the Inquiry have been carefully reviewed. Where necessary redactions and ciphers have been applied to evidence in accordance with the Restriction Orders for Non-Disclosure and Redaction dated 26th March, the Restriction Order for Anonymity dated 26th March 2021 and updated on 29th April 2021, the Restriction order for Special Measures dated 29th April or where the information has been deemed sensitive and/or irrelevant.
9. This Restriction Order prohibits the disclosure and/or publication of any material, including the name of any individual, that has been redacted or ciphered by the Inquiry.
10. Publication includes publishing information on any website, blog, Twitter or other social media.

PENAL NOTICE

11. The High Court and the Court of Session have the power to imprison or fine for any breach of this Order.
