

PUBLIC INQUIRY INTO THE DEATH OF JERMAINE BAKER

RESTRICTION ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 19 INQUIRIES ACT 2005

SPECIAL MEASURES FOR METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE WITNESSES

This Restriction Order is made pursuant to section 19(2)(b) of the Inquiries Act 2005 (“the Act”), read with section 19(3) of the Act.

Any threat to break such an order, or any breach of it, can be certified to the High Court or Court of Session under section 36 of the Act, and the Court will deal with it as though the breach had occurred in proceedings before that Court.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. This Order is made on 15 June 2021 and remains in force indefinitely.
2. The Chairman may vary or revoke this Order by making a further order at any point.
3. Any breach of this Order by any means whatsoever shall be notified in writing to the Solicitor to the Inquiry (STI) immediately upon identification of the breach.
4. The following measures will apply to Supt Simon Stancombe:
 - a. The witness’ image will not be broadcast during any live stream or publication of his/her evidence;
 - b. The witness will be permitted to enter and leave the inquiry room through a route not available to members of the public;
 - c. The media are prohibited from publishing the witness’ image or other identifying feature pursuant to section 11 of the Contempt of Court Act 1981.

PENAL NOTICE

5. The High Court and the Court of Session have the power to imprison or fine for any breach of this Order.
