Notes for Guidance

All Operational Command Decisions and tactical advice must be recorded in sufficient detail to enable recollection and scrutiny during the operation, or at a later date.

THIS IS YOUR ORIGINAL NOTE

- This log is intended to assist Operational Firearms Commanders engaged on authorised firearms operations. Its purpose is to provide a facility to record the events of the operation, deployment decisions made, and operational and environmental advice given / deployments discussed with the Tactical Firearms Commander. It is not intended to replace the recording of firearms tactical advice on Form FA5.
- This log is to be used for one authorised armed operation only and is commenced at the start of an armed operation. For ongoing operations the log will remain an open document. It is to be retained and restarted in the event the operations is stood down and recommenced.
- When the log is full, a new log will be started and events recorded contemporaneously.
- Details of all briefings, further information / intelligence, descriptions of subject, planning and recon completed, deployment decisions and reasons for retention of officers on duty, may be included in the text of the event / decision log.
- Where a deployment decision is made this should be recorded in the event / decision log. A clear reference to the rationale behind each deployment decision should be included in the text or the notes pages if appropriate.
- References to sensitive intelligence sources are **NOT** to be included in this document. If the rationale for a decision emanates from sensitive intelligence sources, and its inclusion would compromise that source, the rationale will be recorded as "on directions of Tactical Firearms Commander".
- This document is to be classified as restricted from the outset, until the contents have been formally reviewed and re-classified if necessary in accordance with METSEC code.
- For criminal case disclosure the log is to be marked as restricted and included on schedule of sensitive material.
- Officers completing this log should refer to all SCO19 operationally deployed officers by their allocated pseudonym in line with SCO19 standard operating procedures.
