

PUBLIC INQUIRY INTO THE DEATH OF JERMAINE BAKER

RESTRICTION ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 19 INQUIRIES ACT 2005

MPS TACTICAL TRAINING VIDEOS

This Restriction Order is made pursuant to section 19(2)(b) of the Inquiries Act 2005 (“the Act”), read with section 19(3) of the Act.

Any threat to break such an order, or any breach of it, can be certified to the High Court or Court of Session under section 36 of the Act, and the Court will deal with it as though the breach had occurred in proceedings before that Court.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. This Order is made on 20 July 2021 and remains in force indefinitely.
2. The Chairman may vary or revoke this Order by making a further order at any point.
3. Any breach of this Order by any means whatsoever shall be notified in writing to the Solicitor to the Inquiry (STI) immediately upon identification of the breach.
4. The material listed at paragraph 5 shall be covered by a Type 2 Restriction Order (T2 RO), to which the following provisions apply:
 - a. The material shall be made available for inspection to any core participant who, in the view of the Chairman, has shown a sufficient interest in the material to be granted access (“an approved CP”) or their legal representatives;
 - b. The material will be covered by the confidentiality undertaking and a reporting restriction.
 - c. Evidence relating to the contents of the MPS tactical training videos shall be heard only in CLOSED session to which only approved CPs are allowed to attend.
 - d. There shall be no reporting of evidence given in this CLOSED session.
 - e. There shall be no OPEN transcript released from the evidence given in the CLOSED session.
 - f. There shall be no broadcast or live-stream of the evidence given in the CLOSED session.

7. The High Court and the Court of Session have the power to imprison or fine for any breach of this Order.
