AJW/17 One black sweatshirt

Apparent medical cuts were present on the front of this sweatshirt. The outer surfaces and inner hems of this sweatshirt were examined for blood. Blood, mainly in the form of very heavy contact staining, was present on the outer surfaces of this sweatshirt. Apparent body tissue was also present to the front of the sweatshirt. An area of the zip, and the fabric immediately next to it, appeared damaged. Similarly, two holes were present to the left sleeve (near the cuff). The damage has not been examined further at this stage.

AJW/18 One black T-shirt

Apparent medical cuts were present on the front of this T-shirt. The outer surfaces and inner hems were examined for blood. Blood, mainly in the form of very heavy contact staining, was present on the outer surfaces of this T-shirt. Two small holes were present on the front of the T-shirt, just below the neckline. This damage has not been examined in detail at this stage.

BEW/7 One left size 8 male blue Adidas running shoe (blood stained)

BEW/8 One right size 8 male blue Adidas running shoe (blood stained)

These items formed a pair of trainers. The outer surfaces and accessible inner edges of both trainers were examined for blood. Blood, in the form of contact staining and numerous small spots, was present on the outer surfaces of each trainer, including the soles.

BEW/9 One black/yellow sock from the left foot of JB

BEW/10 One black/yellow sock from the right foot of JB

These items formed a pair of socks. The outer surfaces and inner edges of both socks were examined for blood. A few blood stains were present on both socks.

RAC/10 One black man bag "Nike"

The outer surfaces of this bag were examined for blood. Blood, mainly in the form of heavy contact staining, was present on this bag. Some areas of the bag appeared mouldy and is likely due to the item being packaged whilst wet. A small hole was present to the bag strap but this has not been examined in detail at this stage.

Most of Jermaine Baker's clothing is heavily blood stained. Of particular note was the heavy staining observed on the Balaclava, jogging bottoms (AJW/13), trainers, T-shirts and sweatshirt. In my opinion, the heavy blood staining on this clothing can be explained by them being worn as the outermost layers when Jermaine Baker was shot.

The blood in the 'lap' area of the jogging bottoms is the result of Jermaine Baker sitting whilst bleeding profusely. The blood on his trainers can be explained by him moving/being moved whilst bleeding.

Overall, the blood on Jermaine Baker's clothing can be explained by him being shot whilst in the front passenger seat of the Audi motor vehicle. Whilst bleeding profusely, he has moved/been moved from the vehicle to where he received medical attention. From the blood staining observed, I am unable to say where Jermaine Baker's left arm was positioned when he was shot.
