Dear Cmdr Ball,

Many thanks to DCS Mason and DCI Williams for attending the meeting today at the Royal Courts of Justice.

Mr Justice Sweeney has now discussed the matter with the Senior Presiding Judge, Lord Justice Gross.

The Senior Presiding Judge is supportive, including of the case remaining at Wood Green, however, the details put in by the Police regarding the operational arrangements need to reflect the discussion this afternoon with Mr Justice Sweeney, in particular as to the circumstances in which armed Officers would be deployed outside the court at Wood Green, and also the need for a quiet survey of the interior of Wood Green in time for Friday. In which event the Senior Presiding Judge is very likely to grant permission for both armed Police Officers outside the court and two covert Police Officers inside the premises.

I would be grateful if the attached form can be amended as requested and forwarded to me as soon as possible, so Mr Justice Sweeney can discuss the matter further with the Senior Presiding Judge. Thereafter, a
