

# **PUBLIC INQUIRY INTO THE DEATH OF JERMAINE BAKER**

---

## **RESTRICTION ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 19 INQUIRIES ACT 2005**

### **LIVE STREAM OF NATHAN MASON'S EVIDENCE**

---

This Restriction Order is made pursuant to section 19(2)(b) of the Inquiries Act 2005 (“the Act”), read with section 19(3) of the Act.

Any threat to break such an order, or any breach of it, can be certified to the High Court or Court of Session under section 36 of the Act, and the Court will deal with it as though the breach had occurred in proceedings before that Court.

#### **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. This Order is made on 13 July 2021 and remains in force indefinitely.
2. The Chairman may vary or revoke this Order by making a further order at any point.
3. Any breach of this Order by any means whatsoever shall be notified in writing to the Solicitor to the Inquiry (STI) immediately upon identification of the breach.
4. The following measures will apply to the evidence given by Nathan Mason on 13 July:
  - a. The witness will give evidence via a video link;
  - b. The witness' evidence will not be broadcast on any live stream.
5. A transcript of Mr Mason's evidence will be available on the Inquiry's website following the conclusion of his evidence. Further submissions will be heard as to whether or not a video of Mr Mason's evidence will be published on the Inquiry's YouTube channel.

**PENAL NOTICE**

6. The High Court and the Court of Session have the power to imprison or fine for any breach of this Order.
