Patient shot by armed police with high velocity rifle approx 15 - 20 mins beforehand. Report of significant blood loss from wound. CPR immediately. LAS report pt still breathing on their arrival with ?PEA whilst HEMS in the overhead.

D: Unresponsive

E: Two wounds identified. One large wound in upper central chest. Second wound seen subsequently on palmar aspect of left wrist. Superficial tissues removed with tendons fully exposed.
