

been able to see it through the windows as it was in the bag on the floor under either seat which were pushed quite far back.

I also recall from memory and not from some small section of transcripts I have read, that before we arrived at Bracknell Close Gokay, Jermaine and I had a conversation about the firearm in the car not being real and the conversation was along the lines of it not being real and if we had got stopped with a real gun we'd be fucked. Also Jermaine, Gokay and I discussed there being an [illegible] canister in the weapon that may have had mine or Jermaines finger prints on as it had been removed from a balloon cannister that I had.

Further to my previous statement after I had been dragged out of the car by police.

I was put on the floor and they put string type handcuffs on me. I next remember being kicked in the right side of my ribs by an officer wearing brown boots who I believe was a male. The officers were saying "DONT LOOK AT ME" and gave me another kick. The female officer then struck me to the left side of my cheekbone area. I think this was done with her gun. This caused redenning and bruising that was later photographed at the police station.

At this time I was laying on my side in a feotal position. I closed my eyes.

The officers then started to cut off my clothes to check me for injuries. While this was happening I was saying "WHY ARE YOU DOING THIS TO ME". I recall at some point the female officer in relation to the shot fired said "IT SHOULD HAVE BEEN YOU". I told her I had my eyes closed.

At this point I had no idea who, if anyone, had been shot.

The officers asked me if I had any injuries to my head and I told them my head felt warm. They removed my hat which was a rolled up black ski mask type hat. The officers then put my hood up so my head wasn't directly on the ground. After this point I remember the officers being less aggressive and their attention was drawn to the other side of the car. I remember someone radioing through to get some uniform officers to get me. While still on the ground I remember looking up and seeing the ambulance helicopter and the staff from the helicopter. I was next put into a police van by two male uniformed police officers. While walking to the van Gokay shouted to me that "THEY'VE SHOT JERMAINE".
