

Audi A6 index KM13YPT which had not moved. Whilst Ozcan EREN was in that vicinity the Audi A6 index KM13YPT was re positioned in the same car park in Palaces Gate estate. This was assessed as Ozcan EREN being engaged in steps to prepare for the “break out” on the 11th December 2015.

On the 8th December 2015 I returned to HMP Wormwood Scrubs, on this occasion with Detective Inspector Lynn SHEPHERD (MPS Prison Intel Unit) and met with Governor Pete NICHOLS. There I briefed him on the intelligence and confirmation of the operational plan. There was no new intelligence to update him on the “break out” risk. I secured his support to facilitate the initial part of the covert surveillance operation and made arrangements for one of my officers to be present at the prison whilst Izzet EREN was being placed on the prison van and to obtain the details of this vehicle at the earliest opportunity. I again emphasised the need for this to be confidential as not to risk any intentional or unintentional compromise of our operation. At this stage it was still not clear how, when, and who were involved in this “break out”. It was still not known who or how the offenders seeking to “break out” Izzet EREN would know which Prison Van he would be travelling in.

On the 10th December 2015 I was aware that the Armed Operation had been authorised by the SFC – FE14. I was aware that FE14 tasked the operational team with ongoing enquiries in order to identify the unknown subjects who were intending to commit this offence and assess the risks posed by those individuals.

On the 10th December 2015 at 3pm I attended an audio recorded operational pre briefing at New Scotland Yard. This briefing was delivered by the TFC – FE16 supported by DC KINCH. All available officers including Team Leaders / representatives of specialist units were invited to attend in order to ensure each team / officer was aware of their role and responsibilities for the operation the next day. They were offered the opportunity to ask questions, seek clarification or provide suggestions.

The decision had been made to run this operational deployment from the Central 3000 (C3000) Covert Operations Room where the TFC – FE16 and key personnel would be based. I decided that I would base myself in that room in order to observe the development of the operation and seek / task evidential opportunities where appropriate.

After consultation the following officers were given responsibilities for the next day. These officer’s roles were allocated as follows:
