This is my detailed statement. I am a serving police officer. I joined the Metropolitan Police in 1993. In 1997 I joined SO19 the force firearms unit. In 2000 I became a firearms instructor and completed a specialist firearms course.

Since then I have rotated between covert firearms operations and instructor duties. I am currently fully operational and posted on a Counter Terrorist Specialist Firearms Team (CTSFO). I am currently First Aid at Work (FAAW) and First Aid at Work Instructor qualified.

On the day of the incident I am aware there were probably CCTV footage, mobile phone camera footage and various press photos taken and I haven't had the benefit of viewing this footage. This statement is an honest and open account of the events that took place.

On Friday the 11th December 2015 I was on duty in my capacity as a specialist firearms officer. The proceeding day I was employed on administration duties covering an 8-4 shift. I was given a start time for Operation Ankaa as 3am on the Friday morning. At this time I paraded at Lemn Street Police Base (HD) with other armed colleagues from my team for a tactical briefing. This briefing was in relation to Operation Ankaa, a pre-planned intelligence led firearms operation. It was given by V64, W97 and W80. Information had been received that Izzet EREN who was held in custody at HMP Wormwood Scrubbs aided by others intended to escape custody whilst being transported from prison to Woodgreen
