buzzer to gain access into the court building and ultimately the cells. It is said this area is where the prison transport personnel are at there most vulnerable and the reason the mission vehicle was waiting at the location.

At shortly after 0900hrs an armed intervention was initiated on the vehicle which resulted in an occupant of the vehicle being fatally wounded.

The occupants were then detained at the scene. Officers discovered an Uzi sub machine gun KK1 in the rear offside foot well of the mission vehicle VRM KM13YPT.

SOGUCAKLI was arrested and cautioned for possession of a firearm with intent to endanger life to which he replied "where's my friend, is he ok".

MASON was arrested and cautioned for possession of a firearm with intent to endanger life to which he made no reply.

MASON was found in possession of a full face ski mask, two hooded coats zipped up and was also wearing a pair of latex gloves covered by a pair of woollen gloves.

SOGUCAKLI was wearing three pairs of jogging bottoms and five layers of upper clothing. Officers later searched his home address and discovered a set of body armour

This evidence clearly shows MASON and SOGUCAKLI are forensically aware, dressed in clothing in order to give them the best possible chance of disguise and escape post prison van attack.

On Friday 11th December 2015 SUGUCAKLI made an unsolicited comment and stated "Why haven't you tested the gun, you can see it's only a pellet gun, that's what they told me when I got in the car, you can buy it for £200 in a shop, it's a toy I was
