On Friday 11th December 2015 I was on duty in plain clothes as part of a pre planned Police operation in a Police Control Room known as Central 3000. My duties were to assist the Tactical Firearms Commander (TFC) whilst the operation was ongoing. Once the operation began I listened to details of Officers movements on the ground via radio and passed details to the TFC who was not always able to listen to the radio whilst speaking with other senior officers in the room. At around 0900hours I was aware that a Firearms team was given 'State Amber'. I know this to mean a Firearms stop was going to be conducted shortly after. There was a short period of radio silence before one officer, whos details I do not know, stated that a stop was being conducted. A short time after that I heard over the radio that shots had been fired. I was aware that requests for the London Ambulance Service, The Helicopter Emergency Medical Service and local officers was made. I remained at my post whilst this was done by a nearby CAD operator. I remained monitoring the radios whilst a second vehicle was stopped by Officers believed to be related to the pre planned operation.
