
The purpose of this statement is to simply evidence the brief phone conversation I had with Daisy Walker in relation to Operation Ankaa.


At 15:16 hours on Thursday 7th April I phoned Personal data 081 and as my call wasn't answered I left a voicemail. I simply introduced myself and asked for Daisy to call me on the number I left for her.

At 15:38 Daisy returned my call and once I had given her the briefest of details as to why I needed to take a statement from her, she said words to the effect of, "if I'm not under arrest then I don't have to speak to you".

I told her that our investigation was about the use of her credit card in relation to the attempted prison van breakout in December and she said something like, "I don't know anything about that".

It was a very guarded phone call from Daisy and it was clear she would not be assisting the investigation and would not provide a statement.
