This is my original note in relation to Operation ANKAA. I make this notes alone on the third floor at Trojan 99 (HD). I did not confer with anyone and make this note from personal recollection.

On Friday 11th December 2015, I was on duty in covert motorcycle equipment. I was employed in my role as a Specialist Firearms Officer. On this occasion I was tasked as the pillion rider on a covert police motorcycle in the company of PCW120. I was covertly armed with a Glock 19 pistol. We were part of a large operation involving two specialist firearms teams. The operation related to a plot to free a prisoner in hand between Wormwood Scrubs prison and Wood Green Crown Court.

We were employed with another motorcycle and (3) other covert armed rescue vehicles. Our role as briefed by V64 was to provide covert protection to the prison van whilst in transit. We configured with Trojan 802 control in Old Oak Common Lane, W12. We awaited the van as it would pass by us travelling west. At about 0900 I heard via the radio that the prison van had left Wormwood Scrubs on route to Wood Green Crown Court. Once the van was west at Old Oak Common Road, W12, we swept out behind it. We maintained a visual control of the van in the company of another motorcycle. (I do not know the other pseudonyms).

The van travelled west until it reached hanger Lane, where it turned northbound on the A406 in the general direction of Wood Green. I was aware of radio traffic from Trojan 801, A black Audi was present near Wood Green Crown Court and contained suspects involved in the conspiracy. A short time later I heard that state Amber had been called on the Audi vehicle at the rear of Wood Green Crown Court. Approximately two minutes later I heard V64 state that shots had been fired at the
