NECESSITY & MATERIAL BENEFIT

State the nature of the investigation or the operation and how it relates to RIPA

Give a short explanation of the crime (or other purpose), the suspect, victim or witness and the communications address and how these three all link together.

This request relates to an ongoing long term investigation that centres around an OCN engaged in the importation and supply of Class A drugs to the London and surrounding areas. This operation has, to date, recovered in excess of 200kg of class A drugs. The OCN utilise telephones to communicate and arrange deliveries. The members of the OCN are aware of Police activity and regularly change their numbers and handsets. The operational plan is to build a conspiracy around the main protagonists and link them with surveillance, communications and phone data.

The EREN family are central figures within one branch of the OCN. On Tuesday 13th October 2015 armed police stopped a high powered motorcycle, index: [DPA] which had been reported as stolen from the Farringdon area on the 18th September 2015. The bike was being by two males: Erwin AMOYAW-GYAMFI (driver), and Izzet EREN (pillion). EREN and AMOYAW-GYAMFI attempted to run from police but were detained following a short foot chase. EREN was arrested about thirty feet from the scene of the bike crash. He was still in possession of his man bag, inside which was found a TOKAREV self loading pistol, which had the hammer pulled back, the safety catch released with a bullet in the chamber ready to fire, and a magazine attached with further unfired bullet cartridges. AMOYAW-GYAMFI was detained after he ran across the road and through a petrol station, having discarded a man bag at the scene of the crash. Inside this man bag was a Skorpion VZ.61 submachine gun, again with a magazine attached containing unfired bullet cartridges. This submachine gun is capable of fully automatic firing, which means two or more bullets can be discharged at the single pull of the trigger. Both EREN and AMOYAW-GYAMFI were wearing crash helmets, motorcycle gloves and balaclavas.

EREN is a member of the Tottenham Boys street gang, who have been engaged in a long running feud with the Hackney Boys which has involved several shootings and murders. From the circumstances of their arrest and the direction of travel it is believed that EREN and AMOYAW-GYAMFI were on their way to carry out a shooting, with the most likely target being members of the Hackney Boys. The intended target of this attack is still unknown and may still be in danger. It is the responsibility of police to identify and intended victims and attempt to prevent any further violence. Other members of the EREN family and the Tottenham Boys remain at large. Izzet EREN is an experienced career criminal and it is believed he will have no difficulty obtaining a contraband mobile phone in prison to communicate with them. Indeed intelligence reports (YRRT00309580) indicate that he has done just that when in prison on previous occasions. It is vital that police identify this number in order to ascertain who EREN is communicating with and disrupt any planned violence.

The EREN's are a close family unit and Izzet will no doubt contact his mother from prison. Call data for: [DPA] 922 (MPS11E00445500) a phone number attributed to Elif EREN, the mother of Izzet has been obtained. From analysis of this call data, a number: [DPA] 606 has potentially been attributed to Izzet and a separate call data application has been submitted (MPS11E00448943). CAD 9827/13NOV15 identifies a number of: [DPA] 897 as belonging to Ozcan EREN (Izzet's brother, who has recently visited him in prison). MPS11E00446872 shows this as a contract phone on the T-Mobile network registered to 'Mr Hasan A'. This phone number is also found on Elif EREN's call data indicating that it is being used by Ozcan. This application is for any details held by T-Mobile, (to include customer notes and payment details) which may identify Ozcan EREN as the user of this number and provide any further addresses, emails or contact numbers for him. This is necessary to attribute this phone number and to identify any further numbers used, which will be the subject of further applications.
