I make this statement further to my original statement dated 11th December 2016 and at the request of the Independent Police Complaints Commission who have asked me a number of questions.

On Friday 11th December 2015 I was assigned to assist the Tactical Firearms Commander in the control room known as Central 3000. I am currently with SC&O19 posted to the Specialist Firearms Support Team who assist with CTSFO Operations and am based at Lemn Street Police Station. During this operation I listened to the main working channel that the surveillance team were using, I listened for the majority of the operation with the exception of comfort breaks away from the radio and from the point the operation started, after shots were fired by Police until I was informed we could leave by the TFC after the arrival of investigating Officers. I passed what I believed to be relevant updates to the TFC and these included movements of the subject vehicle and places it stopped, also where it appeared to be in convoy with a second Audi and when it picked up other persons, all of which were put out by Surveillance Officers. I cannot be any more specific due to the frequency of movement and number of stops made by the subject vehicle. I used my personal ipad to view maps and look at the roads where the subject vehicle was. There was no electronic record of what I was doing. I was moving the map as the vehicle moved. The TFC was also in constant contact with other Officers and was not always stood near me for me to be able to give constant updates. As my duties on the day involved monitoring the radios and being aware of movements on a map I did not make any written notes. **A179**
