AUTHORISATION FOR PROPERTY INTERFERENCE

I have considered this application and I am satisfied that for the reasons which follow that the interference is necessary and proportionate to what is sought to be achieved:

I have considered this file following a presentation from the operational team and I am satisfied that the criminality under investigation is necessary in order to prevent and detect serious crime namely multi kilo Class A drug trafficking and distribution of firearms. This application deals with escaping from prison and justifies interference by way of tracking equipment on the subjects' vehicle.

This activity is proportionate in order to covertly monitor the movements of the subjects to maintain control of the vehicle prior to and during the incident. This action will gather evidence for a successful prosecution and assist in ensuring the safety of all persons involved.

I am conscious that this vehicle is stolen but I do regard this as proportionate as it appears the vehicle will be used in serious crime. Regular reviews will ensure that I do not allow the authority to continue unnecessarily. I am satisfied that other less intrusive means are not likely to achieve the operational objectives.

I consider that the action ~~is~~/is not likely to lead to intrusion on the privacy of person(s) not subject to the action for the following reasons:

I note collateral intrusion is unlikely as the vehicle has been stolen and believed to be under the control of the subjects of this investigation.

A plan is in place to minimise collateral intrusion and in the event that it does occur it will be brought to my attention.

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
In pursuance of Operation UTARA, an investigation into multi kilo class A drug trafficking and distribution of firearms.

Interference with a Black Audi A6 motor vehicle bearing index KM13 YPT (true identity index previous registration of KM13YPT) believed to be used or intended to be used by the subject(s), for the purposes of deploying, maintaining, retrieving and if necessary replacing tracking equipment whilst the vehicle is parked in the residential car park in Eastern Road, Wood Green, N22 7DD and/or any other private/ public place within the Metropolitan Police District (MPD).

Authority to maintain and retrieve the tracking equipment whilst the vehicle is in any public place outside the Metropolitan Police District (MPD).

The subject(s) of this authority are Ozcan EREN, DOB DPA and any other criminal associates believed to be involved in the offences under investigation.

Where operational demands make it impracticable to update the AO immediately prior to deployment, The AO must receive written notification (interim review) at the earliest opportunity (within 24 hours) outlining the other vehicles/ criminal associates and detailing what interference has taken place.
