Continuation of Statement of **S111**

I tasked the surveillance unit to give us an exact location of the vehicle that is parked somewhere in Bracknell Close. They then inform me that the vehicle is parked in a residents parking bay, just past the junction with Olympus Grove on the nearside but pointing out towards the road, they cannot tell me how many people are in the vehicle but the windows have steamed up indicating people are in there. I formulate a plan and pass it on via the radio to the team. I am an Operational Firearms Commander and second in command of my team, the plan is for our vehicles to drive into Bracknell Close, nice and gently, so as not to alert the occupants of the Audi A6.

Some time later we were asked to move forward and arrest the occupants of the Audi A6. As I turned left into Bracknell Close, there were approx 6 workmen in hard hats and fluorescent waste coats on the offside of the road milling around their lorry and just past Olympus Grove on the nearside parked in a residents bay was an Audi A6 motor vehicle with steamed up windows. It was parked nose towards the road and there was a stationary and unattended car parked on its nearside, also in a resident's bay.

As we turned left into Bracknell, I had put the string of my Carbine over my shoulder and put my police baseball cap on. I had my front passenger door opened as we came to a stop and pointing my weapon towards the subject car I quickly moved towards the front passengers' window, it was steamed up and I couldn't see inside. I was shouting 'armed Police' numerous times. I attempted to smash the front passenger window the muzzle of my gun 3 times, as I did the 3rd, W80 said "push on, I've got it" or words to that effect. There was not a great deal of room between the subject's car and the parked car, about 18 inches; again I couldn't see inside the rear near side passenger window, it was also steamed up. I opened the door as I passed it and shouted 'armed Police'.

I could see a Turkish looking male in dark clothing sitting behind the front passenger seat. I couldn't open his door fully because of the other car, I could see both his hands but then he sat back in his seat and brought his hands into his chest, his head and hands were now out of my sight. I was standing alongside the wheel arch. I heard what I believe was a Hatton gun discharge. Thinking that the car was trying to move off and ram its way out and escape. I reached in with my left hand, grabbed the male around the head/collar area and pulled him out of his seat, out of the car, and onto the floor towards the rear of the subject car as quickly as I could, shouting 'Get on the floor' as I did it. As I am doing this, both his hands disappear under his chest, fearing that he is going for a gun, I shout at him to get his hands out. I stamp and kick him 2 or 3 times, whilst covering him with my gun. I do this as I believe he has got a gun. I swear at him as I am shouting. I secure his right arm and place him in a straight arm and shoulder lock, I can now see his other hand as well.

I am then joined by K78 and P2 who assist me in securing the male. A shout of 'Medic' is put up from the front of the car. As a police medic, I respond and run around the offside of the subject car. Its rear offside door is open and I see what looks like an Uzi machine pistol in the foot well of the rear offside passenger and a tyre lever on the back seat. I make my way to the front of the vehicle where I see R116 kneeling on the side of a male, the male is wearing a balaclava.
